Rural areas are in crisis. Revitalization is the solution

Rural areas are in crisis. Rural residents make up 45 per cent of the world's population but bear a disproportionate burden of poverty, malnutrition, and poor quality of life.

The global rural poverty rate is 17 percent (compared to 7 percent in urban areas). Rural people comprise 70 percent of the world's extremely poor. Rural areas lag behind urban areas in reducing rates of child stunting (low height for age). Many rural environments lack basic services such as education; health; roads; water and sanitation; and suffer from rising pollution levels and dwindling natural resources. These challenges will only be exacerbated by climate change.

Conflict and mass displacement increase child labour in the MENA region



A new multi-organizational report finds that conflict and war over the past decade has coincided with an increase in child labour among refugee children, the internally displaced and other populations across the region.

Commissioned by the League of Arab States (LAS) and the Arab Council for Childhood Development (ACCD), the "Child Labour in the Arab Region: a Quantitative and Qualitative Analysis" report is the first to provide an overview of the profile and trends of child labour in the League's 22 member states. "Over the past ten years, during which the region has witnessed high levels of armed conflict resulting in the mass displacement of populations - both within and between countries - the situation has certainly worsened," the report states.

Creating value chains for resilient, underutilized crops

Creating value chains for resilient, underutilized crops like quinoa, sorghum and Salicornia should form the cornerstone of food security and poverty reduction strategies in the face of climate change and other threats to agricultural production and rural livelihoods in member countries of the Islamic Development Bank (IsDB).

This was the consensus of leaders, policymakers, scientists and experts attending a high-level event on sustainable agricultural value chains on the sidelines of IsDB's 44th Annual Meeting held from 3 to 6 April. More than 100 delegates from around 30 countries looked at how climate-smart crops can help to achieve Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) 1 and 2 on no poverty and zero hunger.

Dairy labour agreement workers are now able to access permanent residency pathway.

On 1 April 2019, the Dairy Industry Template Labour Agreement was amended to provide a pathway to permanent residency for overseas workers who have been engaged under a Labour Agreement for a period of at least 3 years
